Drum Launches Consultation for New Homes Community at Causewayend, Bridge of Don, Aberdeen.

On-line Exhibition launched on 27 January 2021

Drum Property Group has submitted a Proposal of Application Notices (PAN) to Aberdeen City Council for a proposed residential development off Scotstown Road, Causewayend in Bridge of Don, Aberdeen.

As part of the consultation process, Drum will launch an online exhibition on 27 January 2021 showcasing plans for the development of up to 350 new homes on the 34-acre site, seen as a 'natural and sustainable extension' of the existing Middleton Park area.

Welcoming the start of the consultation process Graeme Bone, Group Managing Director of Drum Property Group, said:

“Causewayend is a very well-connected site that would provide a natural residential extension to Bridge of Don and the rest of the city. This represents a highly deliverable opportunity to address housing provision shortfalls in the City region, and to secure a fully masterplanned and sustainable community that offers an excellent quality of life.

“We are committed to delivering a sensitive residential development that brings together high-quality accommodation and amenities reflecting the area’s natural landscape, feel and sense of community.

The PAN is submitted in advance of any future planning application and gives an outline intention of the developers plan for the site, prior to a period of public consultation.
